# Supply

#### **Based on Cushman & Wakefield data**

The total office real estate supply in Kazan is more than 450,000 sq. m. and represented by 73 quality business centers and numerous non-specialized proposals including built-in and adjacent premises as well as office premises on the ground floors of residential, storage and retail complexes.

**There are 28 objects of quality supply** (business centers of grades A, B+, B-) with total area of 228,159 sq. m. and estimated rentable area of 164,950 sq. m.

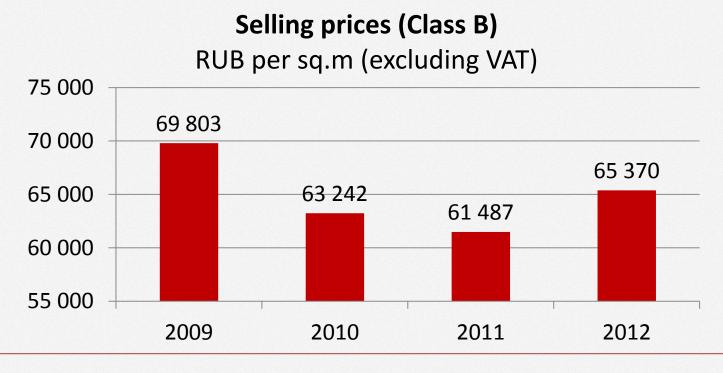

## **Vacancy Rates**

#### Based on Cushman & Wakefield data

The market analysis show that **the share of vacant premises in the segment of quality supply is 3.9%.** 

The vacancy rates in business centers of grades A and B in comparison with 2011 have decreased more than 2.5 times (2011 - to 10.09% of the total market share). As for A class – this indicator decreased by 2.3 times (2011 - 3,24% on the offices of A class).

The dynamics indicates a high rate of absorption and reduction of the period of vacancy premises exposure.

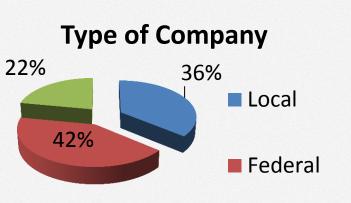

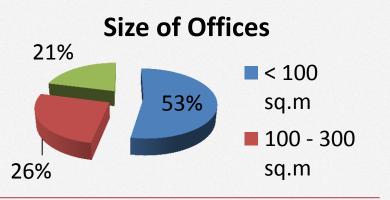
The majority of quality offices (classes A, B) are rented or bought by federal or international companies.

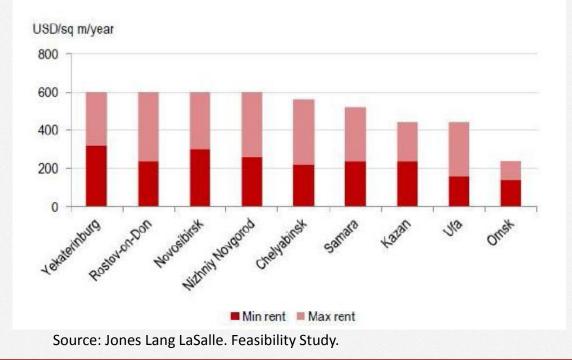

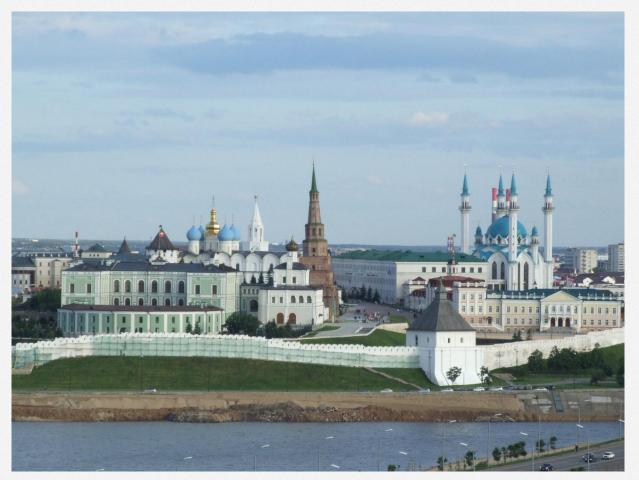

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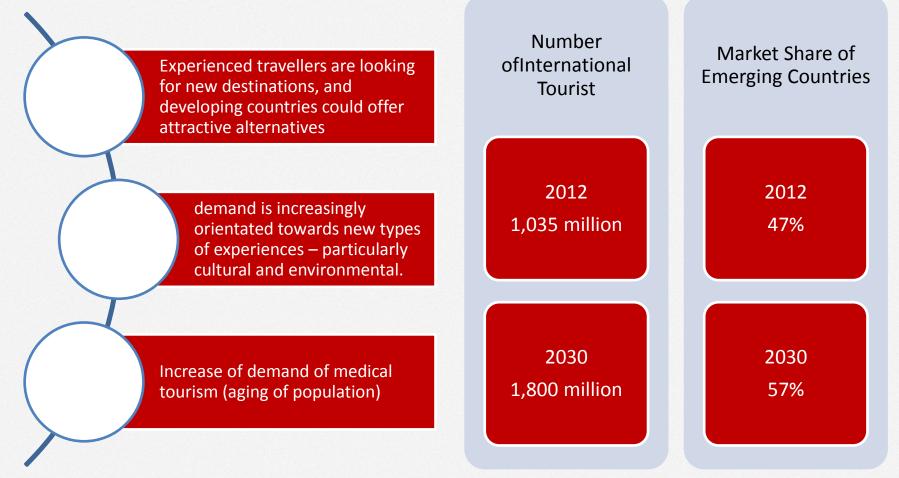

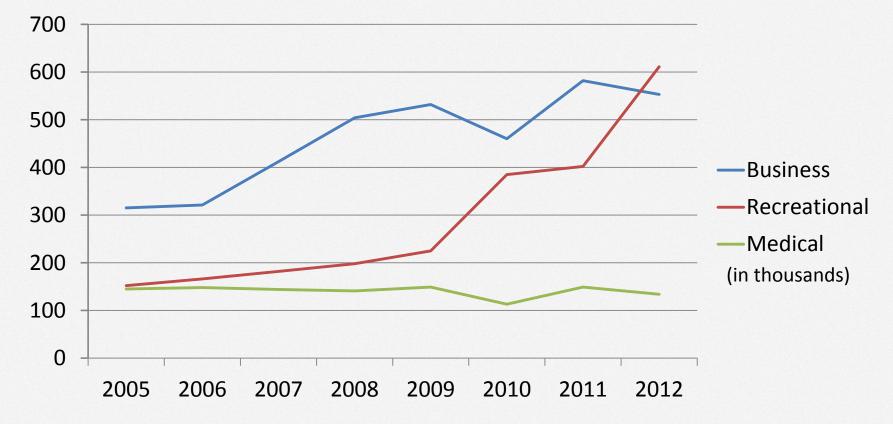

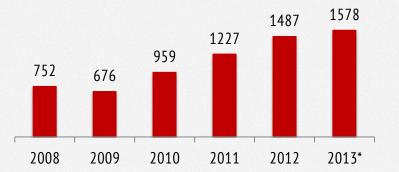
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# Kazan International Airport – a rising star

PI

- Passenger flow doubled 2008-2013, 20% per annum growth
- 2 terminals 3<sup>rd</sup> to be added in 5 years
- Over 2 bln rub. invested in renovation
- Capacity: 3.2 mln  $\rightarrow$  by 2025: 5 mln
- Cargo capacity untapped: ~ 5k tons(2012)
  - 3 k tons outgoing / 1.8 k incoming



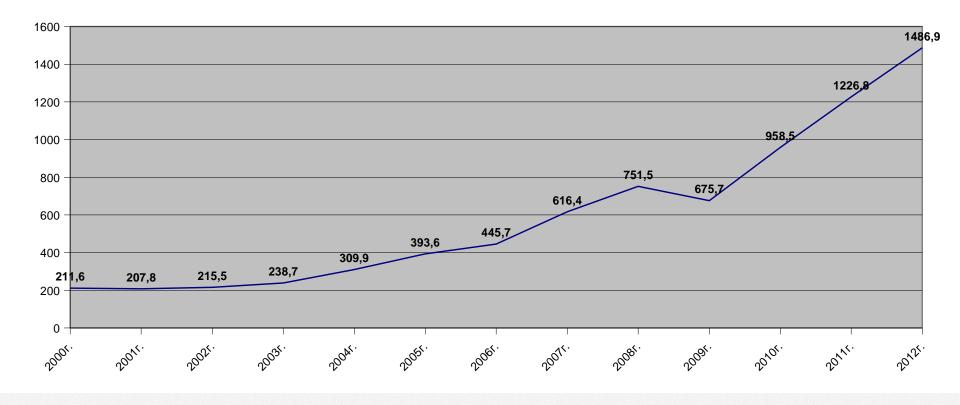








# Kazan International Airport – New Arrival

- Kazan-Moscow cut from 14 hrs to 3.5 hrs
- Investment: 855 bln rub
- Completion date: 2018

# Elabuga

- A historical town above the river Kama which dates back to the 10th century.

- The painter Ivan Shiskin, first Russian female soldier Nadezhda Durova and word-wide famous poet Marina Tsvetayeva lived in Elabuga.
- Historical streets, enchanting sceneries and historical museums.

Medieval capital of Volga Bulgaria from the 8th to the 15th centuries

Religious capital of today's Tatatarstan

Listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site Candidate

# **Sviyazsk**

# Nizhnyaya Kama National Park

- Location: 200 km east of Kazan, neighboring with both Elabuga and Naberezhnye Chelny
- Founded in 1991, area of 265 Km<sup>2</sup>
- Home to moose, roe deer, boar, lynx, badger, eurasian beaver, raccoon dog, endangered specias of bats and over 190 species of birds.

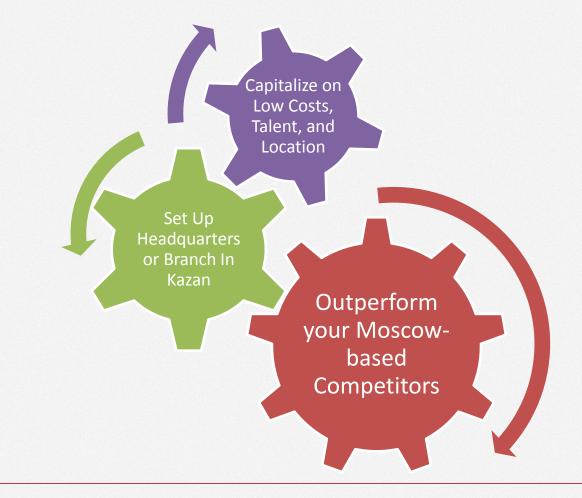
